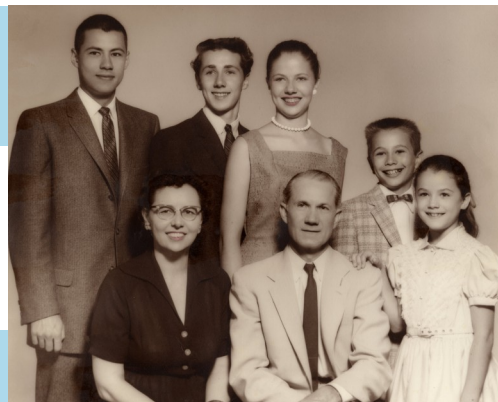

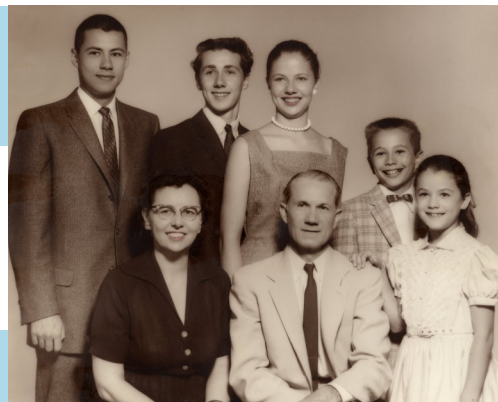

## Descriptions

### Accommodations

2 Bedroom Unit (1 king and 1 queen), with two baths, a kitchen:

- 4 or 5 nights: \$600
- 3 nights: \$500
- 2 nights: \$350

Accommodations will include 2 DVDs/family, 1 with family history files and 1 with reunion pictures.

There will be 4 breakfasts, 2 lunches, and 4 dinners provided. The cost for meals will be:

- \$100/person (age 12-100)
- \$70/person (age 3-11)
- Under 3 is free

Breakfast will be traditional breakfasts prepared by family and served in a common area. The lunches and dinners will be catered from: Dickey's, Café Rio, Cracker Barrel, Ahi's Asian Grill, and others.

The cost of meals includes a reunion t-shirt for all those ages 3 and up.

### Resort

Surrounded by cactus gardens, sandstone spires, and a rich pioneer history, this tranquil desert sanctuary rests far from the bustle of everyday life.

The resort is 42 miles from Zion National Park, 23 miles from Silver Reef Ghost Town, and 8 miles from Snow Canyon.

The resort amenities include: two outdoor pools, two outdoor children's pools, two outdoor hot tubs, two outdoor children's play areas, sports court, arcade games, pool table, ping-

pong, air hockey, fitness center, shuffleboard court, horseshoe pits, three golf courses within a ten minute drive.

Each unit comes equipped with: Internet access, Air conditioning, cable TV, DVD player, stereo with CD player, telephone, gas fireplace, balcony/terrace, gas barbecue, murphy bed, washer and dryer, iron and ironing board, hairdryer

### St. George

Sometime in 1945 the Harold and Maxine Stowell family moved to St. George a small town of under 4,000 people. The family would spend the next seven years there.

Today St. George has 72,897 resident and is considered a very popular tourist destination. The climate is a mild Mediterranean one. While the record high for June was 115, the average daily temperature the third week of June is 82 degrees.

St. George is home to several museums and art gal-

leries, including the St. George Art Museum, the Rosenbruch Wildlife Museum, and the St. George Dinosaur Discovery Site. Coyote Gulch Art Village is in nearby Ivins.

In addition to art galleries and museums there are three performing arts centers: the St. George Opera House, the Electric Theater, and the Tuacahn Amphitheater in Snow Canyon.
